

Legal Education Policies

Committee Members

The Legal Edu. Chair may allow any member of the RBA to join the committee. Similarly, any member of the committee may be removed by the Legal Edu. Chair.

Legal Instructors

Legal Instructors may be hired by the Legal Edu. Chair to teach specific classes. Similarly, Legal Instructors may be removed by the Legal Edu. Chair. Instructors must follow the rules set out in the "Class Policies" section.

Instructors will be paid the amount that tuition is for their class, per student.

Class Curriculums

Each class shall have a curriculum that Instructors shall follow when teaching classes, in accordance with the "Class Policies" below. The Legal Edu. Chair shall propose curriculums for classes to the Legal Education Committee. For 48 hours thereafter, the Legal Education Committee may vote on whether or not to use that curriculum. The curriculum will be imposed if there is a simple majority vote of "Aye." The Legal Edu. Chair may also cancel a vote, resulting in that curriculum not being used.

Class Prices

Class prices will be included in the Class Curriculum.

Class Policies

Instructors shall:

1. Teach through the curriculum created by the Legal Education Committee.
2. Provide teaching through the following mediums:
 - a. Presentation Recordings – This may be a Microsoft PowerPoint, Google Slides Presentation, or something else with the Legal Edu. Chair's approval. These recordings should be provided to students in Discord.
3. Provide teachings in English
4. Be available to answer students' questions

Instructors may:

1. While still providing teachings in English, additionally provide teachings in other languages
2. Provide teaching through additional mediums within this list:
 - a. Discord Voice Chat
 - b. Discord Messages
 - c. Other mediums with the Legal Edu. Chair's approval

3. Provide additional teachings related to the class topic that are not explicitly covered within the provided curriculum.

Instructors shall not:

1. Provide teachings related to other class topics
2. Opt not to teach something that is within the required curriculum
